Description

Scope and Content: This collection provides a glimpse into the personal lives of Mr. & Mrs. Frank E. (Florence) Green from 1938 intermittently to 1946 through the Christmas cards they sent to their staff and friends. The cards contain reprints of photographs of their pets, home, and horses. Cards of this type were not typical of holiday cards sent during this time period and include one card with an artificial composition. Two cards have religious themes.

Abstract: A small collection of Christmas cards from Mr. and Mrs. Green to Mrs. Susann Vaiculevich's mother [Lillian Danforth Wood], who worked for them at the time of the receipt of the cards, as well as four photographs; two portraits, one each of Mr. and Mrs. Green individually, and a single photograph of each with their horses.

Mr. Frank Ewer Green and Mrs. Florence (Johnston) Green were a prominent couple in Flemington. The couple married on 20 June 1923 in Suffern, New York. Frank Green was born 13 Apr 1878 in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon County, to George and Sarah (Hann) Green. He was a lifelong resident of Flemington and worked as a druggist in Flemington until his retirement in 1954. He opened his first pharmacy in 1901, at the Selesnick Men's

Store in Flemington. He later owned and operated the pharmacy from the Green Building on Main Street. Florence Johnston Green was born in Pennsylvania. She was an English teacher at Flemington High School and later the proprietor of Green's Photo Studio in Flemington. She took photos during the trial of Bruno Hauptmann, now known as the Lindbergh Trial. Mr. Green died 20 Nov 1959 in Flemington. After his death, Mrs. Green moved to Buck Falls, Pa.
