Dates of Creation		Administrative Biographical History	John Prall Rittenhouse was born May 17, 1820, in Delaware Township, NJ. He married Susan Huffman in 1845. He was a farmer in Hunterdon County before becoming a state assemblyman as a Democrat in the 1850's and then the Hunterdon County Sheriff in 1871. He was survived by three children, Hawley O. Rittenhouse, Albert Huffman Rittenhouse, and Claude D. Rittenhouse.
