Description	The Huff and Higgins Family Collection, donated by Patricia L. Rauchert, consists of a range of materials. Portraits of family members from the families Huff, Higgins, Dilts, Hoagland, Conover, Ruple, Eick, Bateman, Pierce, and Plum make up the largest part of the collection. There are also a number of portrait images of unnamed people. All the images are undated. The collection also contains a farm guide, two educational hymnals for organ, and three scrapbooks: Scrapbook: Images of Flowers and Fruits; Scrapbook: Philip Philhower, Ringoes, NJ; and Scrapbook: Childhood Images and Cutouts. The Scrapbook: Philip Philhower, Ringoes, NJ contains cutouts from advertisements ranging from 1884-1904. The Scrapbook: Childhood Images and Cutouts is dated from 1888 - 1890. The Huff and Higgins Family Collection can be used for various research such as farm history, organ music history, genealogical history, and research on scrapbooks with illustrations from the late 19th century.
